

## Terms and conditions

By submitting your photograph, you understand and agree that INTALInC has no obligation to publish it. You must be the author and copyright holder of all images submitted.

The deadline for final submissions to the contest is **5pm on 30 July 2021**.

Please read these competition rules carefully. If you enter the competition, we will assume that you have read these rules and that you agree to them.

## Eligibility

1. This competition is open to members of INTALInC only. To sign up to INTALInC visit <https://intalinc.org> and click on 'Join INTALInC'.

## Entry requirements

1. **It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit which include an identifiable person or persons have been taken with the permission of the person or persons pictured and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Provisional competition winners, and any photographer taking part in the INTALInC photographic exhibition, will be asked to provide evidence of consent from any person or people pictured.**
2. Entries must be submitted to [emma.tsoneva@manchester.ac.uk](mailto:emma.tsoneva@manchester.ac.uk) no later than 5pm (UK time) on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
3. Photographs must correspond to one or more of the competition's themes.
4. Entries should be accompanied by an explanatory caption of no more than 20 words.
5. One photograph will be accepted from a single entrant. No third-party entries, bulk entries, or entries submitted by agents will be accepted.
6. The competition is for digital photographs only, which must be at least 1800 x 1200 pixels in size
7. Prizes will be limited to only one per entrant
8. We will disqualify any entry which INTALInC believes to be abusive or indecent or otherwise breaches these terms and conditions
9. We are not responsible for entries which are lost or corrupted, or for any technical errors in the submission of entries
10. All entries submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have won a prize in any other photographic competition
11. Entrants must only submit their own work and must own the copyright for their entry.
12. **Copyright for all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, each entrant grants permission to INTALInC to feature their submitted image in its publications, its website, social media and/or any promotional material connected with this competition. Images used by INTALInC will be credited as the work and sole copyright of the entrant.**
